Key Nursing News – July 2025

1. Understaffing in Maternity Services

A Guardian investigation highlights a looming crisis: around 80% of student midwives fear they won't secure NHS posts after qualifying due to funding cuts and recruitment freezes, despite the country facing a shortage of over 2,500 midwives

2. NMC Updates: Leadership & Process Improvements

The Nursing & Midwifery Council named Paul Rees MBE as its new permanent Chief Executive & Registrar and reported faster "fitness to practise" case processing – now completing decisions for 70.4% of cases on average

3. Launch of the NHS 10-Year Plan

Prime Minister Keir Starmer and Health Secretary Wes Streeting unveiled an expansive NHS strategy emphasizing:

Expanded nurse roles in primary care

The Royal College of Nursing signalled support, underscoring the central role for nurses in delivering these reforms

4. New Immigration Rules for Care Workers

Starting 22 July, the UK will close the care-worker visa route and raise skilled-worker visa requirements – part of shifting toward UK-trained staff

5. Drop in International Joiners to UK Nursing Register

Recent NMC data shows international healthcare professionals joining the UK register fell by 30% in 2024–25, while UK-trained joiners increased by nearly 6%. Concerns remain about physical and mental health prompting registrant departures
