

April Nursing Updates - Key Highlights This Month:

Pay Increase Introduced

April sees a 3.3% pay rise for NHS staff, including nurses under Agenda for Change. While welcomed, unions continue to highlight ongoing cost-of-living pressures.

Workforce Pressures

Nursing services remain under strain, with high workloads and staffing shortages still impacting both patient care and staff wellbeing across the UK.

Recruitment & Retention

Although nurse numbers are growing overall, some regions continue to face challenges with vacancies, retention, and job availability for newly qualified staff.

Community Care Funding

An increase in NHS-funded nursing care (FNC) has been introduced to support care homes and reduce pressure on hospitals, strengthening community-based services.

Key Focus

National priorities remain centred on improving retention, supporting staff wellbeing, and building a more sustainable nursing workforce for the future.
